In its 32nd edition and with the goal of preserving and promoting Flamenco's artistry, history, and culture, this Festival brings the finest Flamenco artists to Albuquerque.

Each June, *Festival Flamenco Alburquerque* brings the finest Flamenco artists in the world to this city. From June 15th to the 22nd, Albuquerque will be filled with the pulse of Flamenco and transformed into a cultural epicenter for the art form. This year's edition presents artists Olga Pericet, Manual Liñán, Sergio de Lope, Belén López, Concha Jareño, and Lucía Álvarez "la Piñona".

The Festival also includes a series of 30 workshops and lectures to explore the history and development of Flamenco, its dance, and its sound patterns. These classes are available and designed for students of all ages and backgrounds, creating a multi-generational, diverse atmosphere that promotes excellence, knowledge, and personal growth.
