Set in the arid earthiness of 1970's post-Franco Spanish North Africa, this raw and cinematic vision is a powerful account of the defiantly free-spirited woman and her obsessive lover, set to Bizet's intoxicating score.

Jennifer Johnson Cano, critically acclaimed for her star turn in BLO's 2015 production of *Don Giovanni*, returns to Boston as the fiery, seductive gypsy who destroys the naïve soldier Don José, played by Roger Honeywell. BLO Music Director David Angus conducts.
