María José Llergo's diverse musical training in classical violin, jazz, gospel, salsa, raga, and flamenco forms the foundation for her exploration of a hybrid sound. She blends her entire musical background into sophisticated pop and contemporary flamenco, creating a boundary-breaking experience. She released the *Sanación* EP in 2020. In 2022, Llergo won the Goya Award for Best Song for



The Sea Awaits You, the title theme from the 2021 film *Mediterráneo*. Her second album, *Ultrabelleza*, was released in October 2023.

Llargo honors a genre of music that is more sincere about Spain's history than most textbooks.
