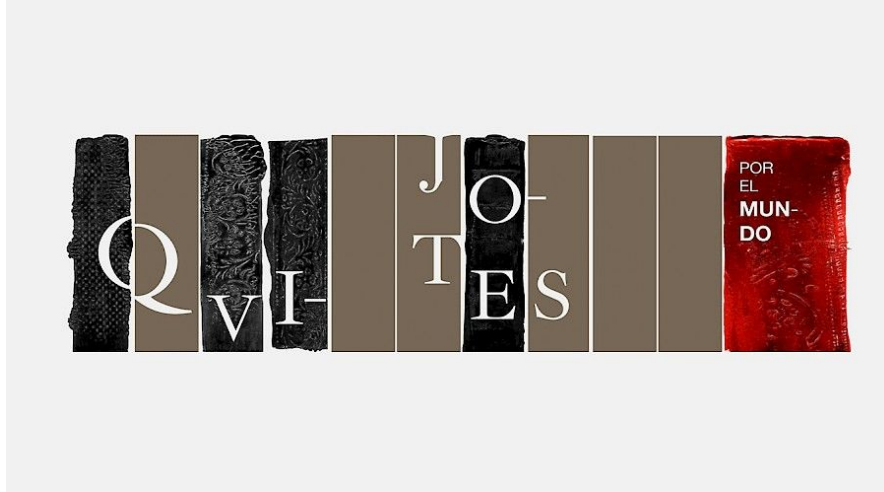




# Quixotes Around the World



*Quixotes Around the World* represents the voice of the work's readers in 30 different languages, and features iconographic and film translations and adaptations for children.

*Quixotes Around the World* shows the rich holdings of the Instituto Cervantes's network of libraries and, at the same time, pays tribute to the hundreds of translators of Cervantes's work who, over a period of 400 years, have made it possible to disseminate Cervantes and his texts worldwide.

It features iconographic and film translations and adaptations for children and young readers, as well as representing the voice of the work's readers in 30 different languages.
