He will present, along with master guitarist Joan Vinyals, part of his recent book, *The lost rhythm*.

KIKO VENENO

- A pioneer in the fusion of flamenco, pop and rock, Kiko Veneno collaborated in 1979 on the legendary album *La Leyenda del Tiempo* with Camarón de la Isla, writing the song *I'm Flying*. His album *Echate un Cantecito* sold 300,000 copies and is a main reference for artists like Martirio, Julieta Venegas, Muchachito Bombo Infierno, Mala Rodríguez and The Planets.
