Jordi Virallonga Eguren is a Spanish essayist, translator and poet in both Catalan and Spanish languages. Virallonga, born in Barcelona in 1955, holds a PhD in Spanish Literature. He teaches at the University of Barcelona, and is founding president of the Aula de Poesía de Barcelona since its inception in 1989. Virallonga has served as Spanish lecturer at the University of Turin and guest professor at various American, European, and African Universities. Year after year the International Literature Festival brings the creative work of some of the most outstanding writers of the Americas. Spanish poet Jordi Virallonga Eguren is among the many outstanding authors participating in the International Literature Festival this year.
