Born Maria Concepcion Balboa Buika in Palma de Mallorca, Spain, Buika grew up immersed in Spanish culture with her African-born parents. Surrounded by multiple cultures throughout her life, Buika had a variety of musical influences, from jazz and flamenco to pop, soul and African polyrhythm.

This eclectic upbringing shaped Buika's ability to make music without limitations. During her 16-year recording career, her albums flow seamlessly between pop, jazz, soul, reggae, afro beat, R&B and flamenco. Equally diverse are her collaborators, which include Pat Metheny, Anoushka Shankar, Chick Corea, Nino Josele, Bebo and Chucho Valdez, Seal and Nelly Furtado. For Buika, her music is more than a career. She says, "Sometimes in the music business, people do what they think other people will like. But that's a limitation. I just want to be true... I just do what my heart is demanding."
