

Calderon's Two Dreams



Magis Teatre Company performs "Calderon's Two Dreams," a repertory performance of two classics by Pedro Calderon de la Barca.

Calderon de la Barca's work is regarded as the culmination of the Spanish Baroque theater. His two classics *–Life is a Dream* (1635) and *Life is a Dream* (1677)– will be performed by theater company Magis Theatre, an actor-driven ensemble known for making classical works enjoyable and accessible to contemporary audiences.

Calderon's first masterpiece *Life is a Dream* (1635) deals with questions of freedom and choice in a confusing reality. As his career soared, he felt the need to go deeper into his own spirit; he completely re-wrote it to examine deeper questions. In 1677's *Life is a Dream* the setting changes to the court of the universe. The central question of the earlier version "will this prince be a fitting ruler?" in the later version becomes "is the human being a fitting caretaker of the universe?"
