JOSEMI CARMONA & JAVIER COLINA: DE CERCA

Supported by years of friendship and collaboration, *De Cerca* represents the musical encounter between the Dlamenco guitar of Josemi Carmona (son of prestigious guitarist Pepe Habichuela and leader of the legendary band *Ketama*) and the double-bass playing of Javier Colina (a regular of Bebo and Chucho Valdés or Jerry González). Jazz & Flamenco share common roots in this virtuoso project that joins two essential names of Spanish music nowadays.

ALFONSO AROCA: ORILLA DEL MUNDO

Last summer Alfonso Aroca won the award for the best flamenco instrumentalist in Spain. He surrounds himself with a group of young, first-rate musicians who help him to raise the flamenco tradition to new heights. *Orilla del Mundo (Shore of the World)* is his de?but album which he will present at the festival.
