

Interpretive Realms with Carolina Sauca



The exhibition features art that represents the physical expression of the sensitivity, ingenuity and integrity of talented artists who use their impressive skills to share their thoughts and ideas with others.

Carolina Sauca paints a combination of figurative and abstract work with warm colors and a particular stylized grace that is calming and beautiful.

Her work shimmers with the suggestion of movement and energy, yet is simultaneously still and reflective. Attracted to a variety of different media, Sauca creates art with oils and acrylics as well as polymers, wax, copper, mirrors, and fabric to present her own fresh, spontaneous artistic perspective.

To carry out my work, I use both simple everyday objects such as spheres, cubes or other geometric shapes, and figurative or abstract representations of nudes and floral elements that awaken in me an interest to capture them using different techniques, she explains. Driven by a need to connect the external and emotional world, Sauca creates work that embodies her own inner energy in a way that connects to viewers on a visceral level.
