Joan Vázquez, the stage star for Spain's productions of *Merrily We Roll Along*, *Hair*, *Rent*, *My Fair Lady*, and *Mamma Mia!* is back in New York after a successful performance at Feinstein's/54 Below cabaret on July 5. Vázquez debuted *Something's Coming* at Teatre Gaudí in Barcelona and at Nuevo Teatro Alcalá in Madrid, Spain, and will now be singing in English in New York.
