- Born Pablo Díaz-Reixa in the Canary Islands, the Spanish-owned archipelago off the coast of Northwestern Africa, El Guincho found indie blog fame in early 2008, shortly after the previous December's release of his album *Aleganza*, which coincided nicely with his North American debut performance in Austin, Texas, at the SXSW festival. It was while touring with the band Coconut in 2006 that the idea for El Guincho –blending samples of his favorite tropicalia and calypso along with percussion and his own vocals– came about.

York and began working as a sound designer/mixer and music composer for film. She also started producing music with traces of Tropicalia, leftfield R&B, traditional Spanish melodies and experimental sound design under the name of NOIA, which means “girl” in catalan. She sings in Spanish, English and Catalan.
