Movie lovers and foodies won't want to miss the program *The Art of Food*. Utilizing the five senses, sensibility, and creativity, *The Art of Food* discovers and experiments with the relationship between cinema and cuisine.

The program proposes a delicious menu. Participants will watch and savor two of the latest gastronomical films, *Sherry & the Mystery of Palo Cortado* (José Luis López Linares, 2015), and *Snacks: bocados de una revolución* (Verónica Escuer and Cristina Jolonch, 2015).

The former will culminate in an evening cocktail demonstration and tasting for the guests. The latter will feature a discussion with some of the film's internationally-renowned Spanish chefs. The menu is complemented by four additional movies and a talk by Chef Paco Roncero about the evolution of Spanish gastronomy. For the last course, the public can participate in wine, oil, and jamón ibérico tastings and workshops.
