After two decades dedicated to academics, she broke onto the literary scene in 2009 with the publication of the *New York Times* bestselling novel entitled *The Time in Between*, followed by *The Heart Has Its Reasons* in 2012. Both novels have become international bestsellers and have been translated into 35 languages. The television adaptation of *The Time in Between* earned critical and international acclaim. *The Vineyard* is her third novel.
