Brown University celebrates contemporary literature in Spain by bringing four innovative poets to campus to meet with students, scholars, professors, and the Ibero-American community.

The festival will culminate in two major evening readings, but will also include afternoon discussions and a seminar on translation. Main topics of discussion:

- The role of anthologies in determining literary legacy in Spain.
- The state of (overlapping) aesthetic, publishing, and linguistic communities of poets in Spain.
- A consideration of what gets translated and why.
