Spanish Compañía Nacional de Danza presents "Carmen" by choreographer Johan Inger, a reimagined version of Georges Bizet's masterwork.

Founded in 1979, Compañía Nacional de Danza returns to the Mondavi Center with a work that is a statement of its compelling artistic direction. Johan Inger's *Carmen* is a retelling of mythic and universal elements of passion and violence. Debuting in 2015, and winning the coveted Benois de la Danse prize for choreography in 2016, this contemporary *Carmen* tells the tale through the eyes of a child, with its heroine a courageous and modern woman, the mountains of Ronda reimagined as poor suburbs, the military now senior executives and the bullfighter recast as a movie star.
