Grammy Winner Victor Prieto is hailed by *The New York Times* as "A fiendishly skilled accordionist and composer" and by *All About Jazz* as "One of the best World music and Jazz accordionists nowadays." He has changed the way musicians and spectators view accordion by revolutionizing both technique and sound (chord approach on both hands). His love for the traditional Galician music and classical education enriches his compositions with explosive rhythm and colors uniquely combining Galician Roots, Celtic, Brazilian, Jazz, Tango, and Classical Music.
