Three outstanding Latin Jazz piano players will guide us in this odyssey: Chucho Valdés, in Lecuona's native Havana, who fuses jazz with Afro-Cuban rhythms; Michel Camilo in New York, who creates elegant soundscapes; and Gonzalo Rubalcaba, who fuses Latin Jazz with Flamenco.
