The 6th Edition of Puerto Rico's Festival de la Palabra will take place this October in San Juan. These year the Festival is dedicated to the poet Francisco Matos Paoli, in the celebration of the centenary of his birth (1915). The outstanding contribution of filmmaker, writer and a playwright Jacobo Morales will also be recognized.
