



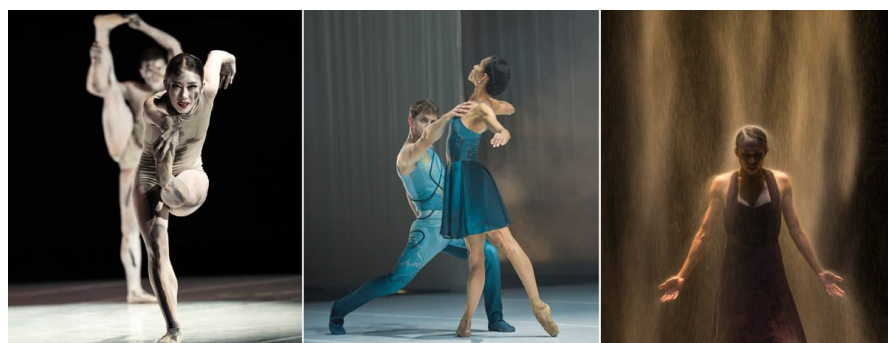
The National Dance Company of Spain's 2024 U.S. Tour in Seattle



Compañía Nacional de Danza, Spain's premier national dance company, returns to Seattle after 14 years to present a trio of performances covering classical, neoclassical, and contemporary dance: "Sad Case," "White Darkness" and "Passengers Within."
