The 16th annual International Film Festival, which runs September 19-28, 2019, showcases the largest collection of short films on the east coast, followed by discussions and events with local and visiting filmmakers. Out of more than 1200 entries from around the globe, there have selected 156 unique films that will screen in 19 showcases that reflect the 38 nations they represent.
