World Music star Buika is one of the most sought-after performers on the world stage today.

Buika (María Concepción Balboa Buika, born in Mallorca) is blessed with a remarkable voice, often garnering comparisons to Nina Simone, Chavela Vargas and Cesarea Evora.

Her recordings have earned multiple awards, including several Latin Grammys. Her seventh album, 2013's *La Noche Más Larga (The Longest Night)*, which features several original songs, was nominated for a 2014 Grammy for Best Latin Jazz Album. Her Fall 2015 release, *Vivir Sin Miedo*, is "a fusion of all the experiences, feelings, lessons, passions, and rhythms that Buika has incorporated into her creative DNA" and is infused with elements of reggae, ragga, flamenco, R&B, Afrobeat, and gospel.

NPR has listed her among the best 50 vocalists of all time, calling her *The voice of freedom*.
