


La Oreja de Van Gogh in Washington, D.C.

La Oreja de Van Gogh, literally The Ear of Van Gogh, launched their first album *Dile al Sol* in 1998, which was followed in 2000 by their next and most celebrated album, *El viaje de Copperpot*. They quickly became one of the most popular Spanish bands in the early 2000s, spreading their major hits around the world. Their success was recognized by awards such a a Grammy Latino and two MTV awards.

After more than 20 years composing songs together, they are presenting their 7th album called *El Planeta Imaginario*, and will tour the U.S. from May 2017.
