La Verbena de la Paloma (The Festivity of the Virgin of the Dove) is one of the most popular *zarzuelas* (Spanish operetta) of all times. Set in Madrid in the late 19th century, the story focuses on sweethearts Julian and Susana, whose love endures the amusing meddling of an old bachelor suitor.

As background to the plot, this *zarzuela* presents a parade of characters drawn from Madrid's *Belle Epoque*. The dialogues are sharp and witty, and the catchy music includes some of the most celebrated *zarzuela* tunes, such as the famous *habanera*, *¿Dónde vas con mantón de Manila?*
