pharmaceutical tranquilizers and other ingredients. The village of La Mancha, where they reside, suffers from the gambling addiction of its residents and leaders, who have decided to sell it. The inhabitants face forced sales and eviction, but Rosario's house and the lagoon are located in the heart of the municipal district. Therefore, she organizes a resistance to the best of her ability.

Liz Lobato is a Madrid-based actress and director with over 28 years in acting and 14 years in directing, holding a Philosophy degree from the Sorbonne, a master's in Screenwriting from the University of London, and currently pursuing a PhD in Film at Queen's University, Belfast.
