"Spanish Cinema Now" returns for its 7th edition, bringing the best cinema made in Spain to DMV audiences.

AFI Silver Theatre and the Cultural Office of the Embassy of Spain in Washington, D.C. co-present *Spanish Cinema Now*, an annual festival of outstanding new films that reflect the breadth of styles and talents at work in Spain today.

Highlights include:

- the East Coast premiere of Saturn Return, the new film from acclaimed director Isaki Lacuesta, loosely based on the real story of '90s indie rock band Los Planetas;
- the East Coast premiere of *Un Amor*, Isabel Coixet's feminist drama starring Laia Costa (Lullaby, Victoria);
- Jokes & Cigarettes, a Goya Award—winning '60s-set biopic about Catalan comedian Eugenio Jofra;
- Mamífera, an abortion dramedy that recently won a Special Jury Award for Maria Rodríguez Soto's performance at the 2024 SXSW Film Festival.


