


Spotlight on Contemporary Spanish Theater: La Ternura



This staged reading of Alfredo Sanzol's "La Ternura," which narrates the adventure of a queen and her two daughters traveling on the Invincible Armada, is part of "Spain in DC | Cultural week."

Spanish theater is a reflection of the land where it is created: culturally rich, and diverse. Rooted in a strong tradition of theater coming from the XVI century, contemporary Spanish theater is a blend of voices and styles exploring the issues of our time.

La Ternura (Tenderness) tells the story of a somewhat magical queen and her two daughters, traveling on the Invincible Armada, forced by King Philip II to marry English nobles for convenience, after having invaded England. Queen Maragda hates men because they have always controlled her life and taken away her freedom, so she is not willing to let her daughters suffer the same fate.

When the Armada passes close by an island that the queen believes to be deserted, she causes a great storm that sinks the ship they are sailing on. Her plan is to stay and live on that island with her daughters so that she will never have to see a man again...

ABOUT THE DIRECTOR

Michael Windsor is back at the Embassy of Spain after directing readings of *Escaping Labyrinths* and *The Lost Children* in 2019. He is a four time Helen Hayes nominated director and Co-Artistic Director of Monumental Theatre Company. Windsor has worked on the directing team on a variety of workshops and shows across the DMV, including *Titanic*, *Blackbeard*, and *Light Years* at Signature Theatre as well as *James and the Giant Peach* at Adventure Theater.

Windsor's direction has been praised for being "unconventional" and "a refreshing take on musical theatre." Other directing credits include:
