INDOORS EXHIBITS

- *SPAINfographics* tells a visual story on the topic Spain in the United States through infographic designs.
- *Ramón y Cajal by Brais Rodríguez*. As part of the sixth edition of *Not Your Regular Wall*, Spanish artist Brais Rodríguez imprinted the walls of the Spanish Cultural Center with his artistic proposal Ramón y Cajal in celebration of the 170th anniversary of the Spanish scientist's birth.

OUTDOORS EXHIBITS

- *DC.es: Outdoors* showcases works by five Spanish artists on their perspectives of the world's political capital on the outdoor fence of the Cultural Center.
- *Pride Month 2024: Color me Proud*. We celebrate Pride Month with a banner that embraces diversity, and Spain's commitment to LGBTQI+ rights.
- *Around Blooming, Around Reforesting by Doa Oa*, a work that creates a deep and empathetic connection with flowers and nature, promoting the appreciation of their beauty, awareness of plant diversity, and the historical relationship between humans and plants through pictorial interventions and reforestation projects.
