Amarist is a duo of artists based in Barcelona, Spain. Active in Contemporary Art and Design, their work is characterized by a bold visual power and the ability to simulate the thoughts of the observer. Their work has been exhibited internationally in cities and art events such as Dubai, London, Art New York, Venice Biennale, and Art Miami; and has been published in printed media such as *Forbes, Financial Times, Harper's Bazaar*, and *Elle Decoration* among others.
